**This application is based on the following terms and conditions and for the purposes stated herein:**

- 1. BURNING WILL ONLY BE ALLOWED AFTER YOU HAVE CALLED CLACKAMAS FIRE DISTRICT #1 TO DETERMINE IF IT IS A BURN DAY.**
2. Only natural vegetations shall be burned. The fire shall not contain any lumber, rubber products, asphalt products, petroleum products, plastics, garbage, dead animals, or any waste material that emits smoke or creates offensive odors.
3. Persons and equipment capable of extinguishing the fire shall be on the burn site and in attendance at all times.
4. The air contaminants emitted from the outdoor fires shall not be in sufficient quantities, and of such characteristics and duration as is, or is likely to be, injurious to human health, plant or animal life, or property, or which unreasonably interferes with enjoyment of life and property.
5. Particulate matter from the outdoor fires must not be allowed to become deposited upon the property of others.
6. Only one pile shall be burned at one time, unless a special permit has been issued by Clackamas Fire Dist. #1.
7. A copy of the burn permit shall be on location where you are burning.
8. The permit shall not be valid during any air pollution episode or period of impaired air quality by D.E.Q. standards.
9. The permit shall only be valid during the months of March, April, May, June, October, November and December.

Note: Any permit issued may be revoked for the protection of life or property or to prevent or abate the nuisances caused by such burning and/or violation of the Happy Valley Municipal Code 8.08.110. (A nuisance would be defined as ash fallout or smoke accumulation in the area of residential occupancies).
