## Annual Summary

During 2012, the Clackamas County Sheriff's Office provided law enforcement service to the City of Happy Valley on a 24 hour a day basis. During this time period, the Sheriff's Office answered 3,251 radio calls for service, which was an average of 270.9 calls per month and 8.9 calls per day.


An overall look at the shift activity reflects the following percentages of calls taken, traffic stops made and reports written in 2011.

### 2012 Calls for Service by Shift

















**2012 Traffic Stops and Citations by Month**




