## Annual Summary

During 2014 the Clackamas County Sheriff's Office provided law enforcement service to the City of Happy Valley on a 24 hour a day basis. During this time period, the Sheriff's Office answered 3,517 radio calls for service, which was an average of 293.1 calls per month and 9.6 calls per day.


An overall look at the shift activity reflects the following percentages of calls taken, traffic stops made and reports written in 2013.

### 2014 Calls for Service by Shift





### 2014 Calls for Service by Month




### Yearly Calls for Service










# Happy Valley Reported Thefts 2014






# Happy Valley Reported Criminal Mischief 2014






# Happy Valley Reported Burglaries 2014


## Traffic
