## Annual Summary

During 2015 the Clackamas County Sheriff's Office provided law enforcement service to the City of Happy Valley on a 24 hour a day basis. During this time period, the Sheriff's Office answered 3,882 radio calls for service, which was an average of 323.5 calls per month and 10.6 calls per day.


An overall look at the shift activity reflects the following percentages of calls taken, traffic stops made and reports written in 2015.

### 2015 Calls for Service by Shift




