

# **Monthly Summary**

During September 2019, the Clackamas County Sheriff's Office provided law enforcement service to the City of Happy Valley on a 24 hour a day basis. During this time deputies assigned to Happy Valley responded to 374 calls for service, which was an average of 12.5 calls a day.

Below is a chart showing the number of calls for service in the City during the last 5 years.






## **Traffic**




There were 7 arrests for Driving Under the Influence of Intoxicants (DUII).
