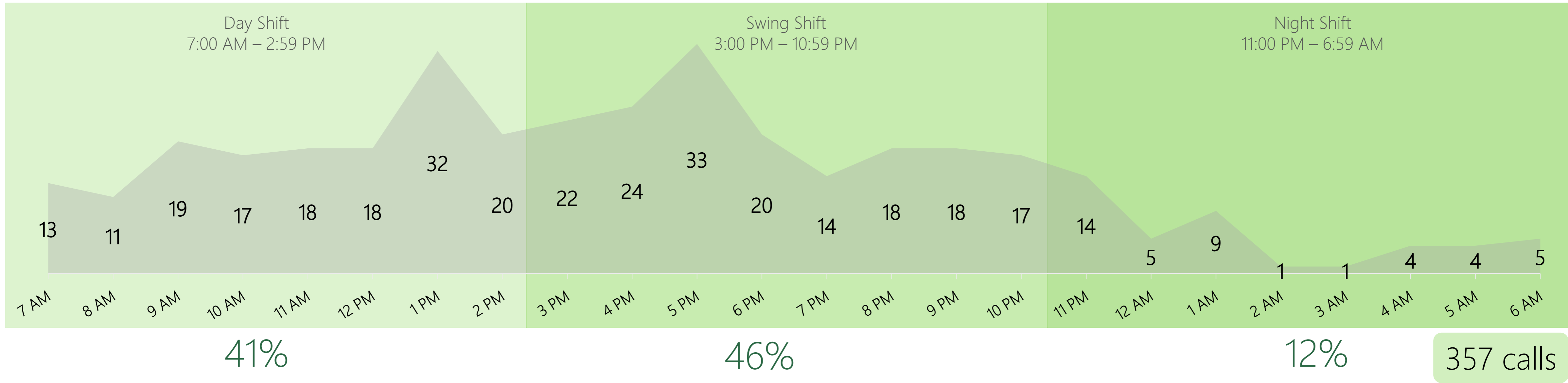

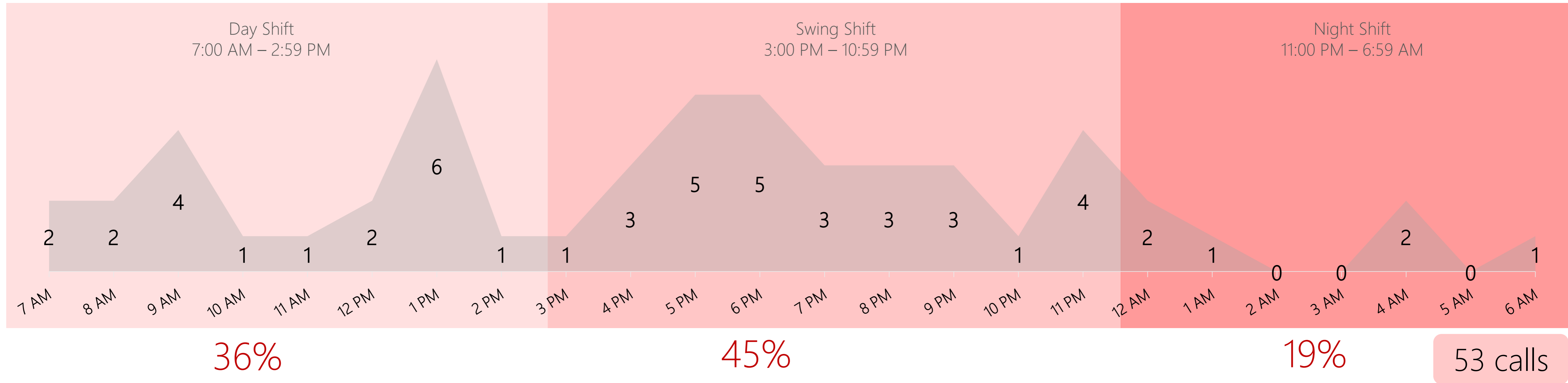
## Dispatched Calls for Service Breakdown by Hour of Day & Shift Time Groupings

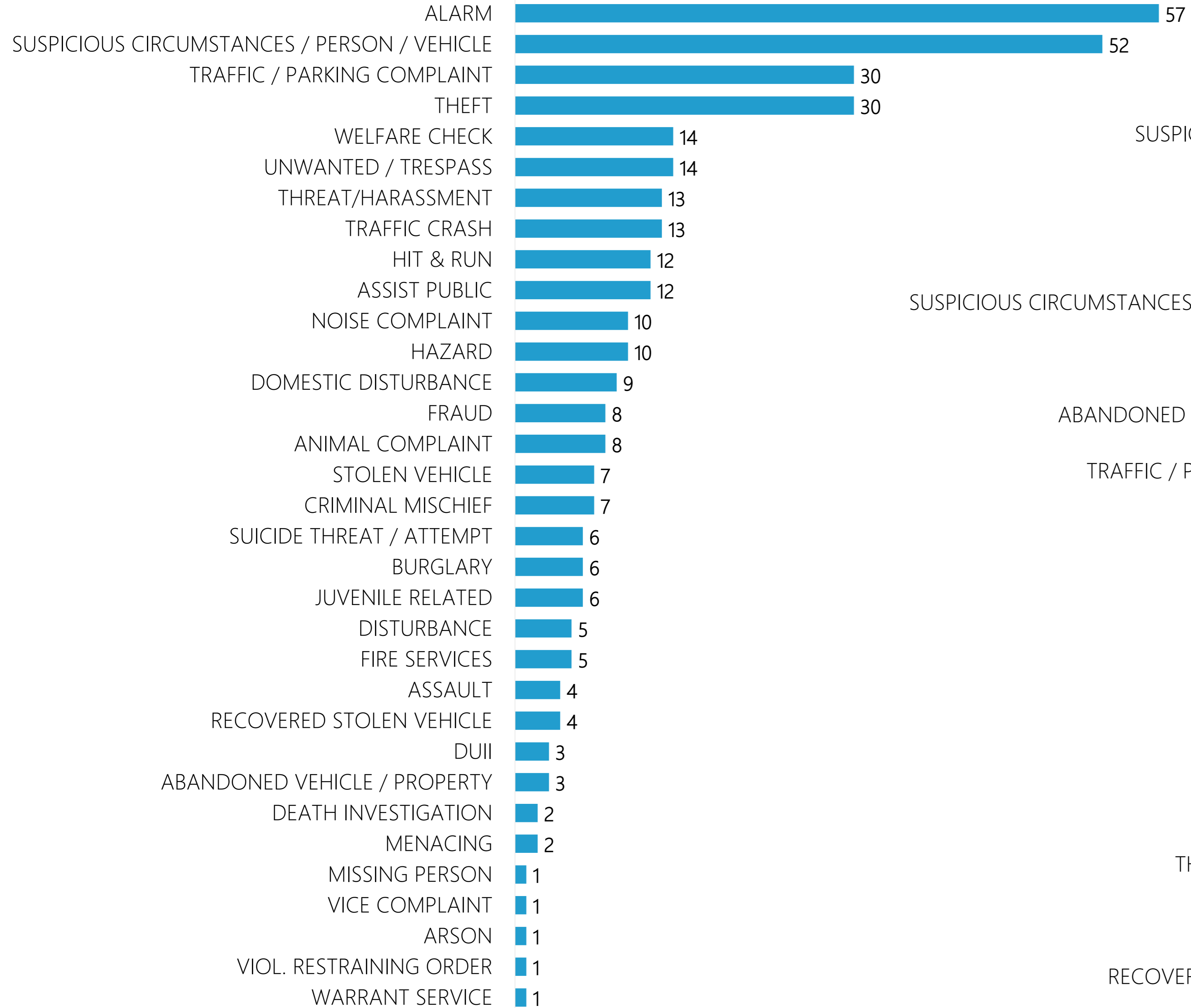

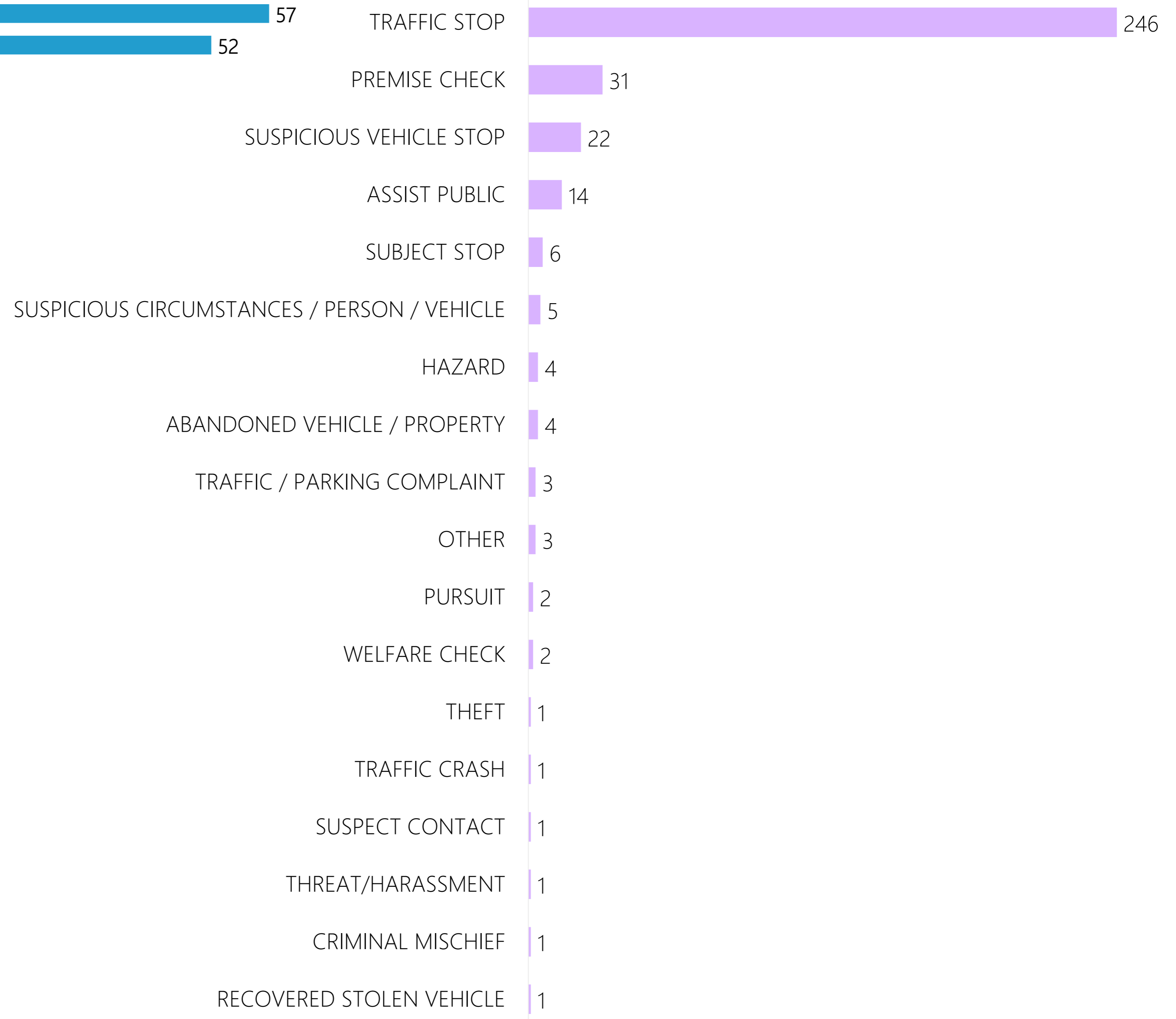
Priority 1 & 2 Calls

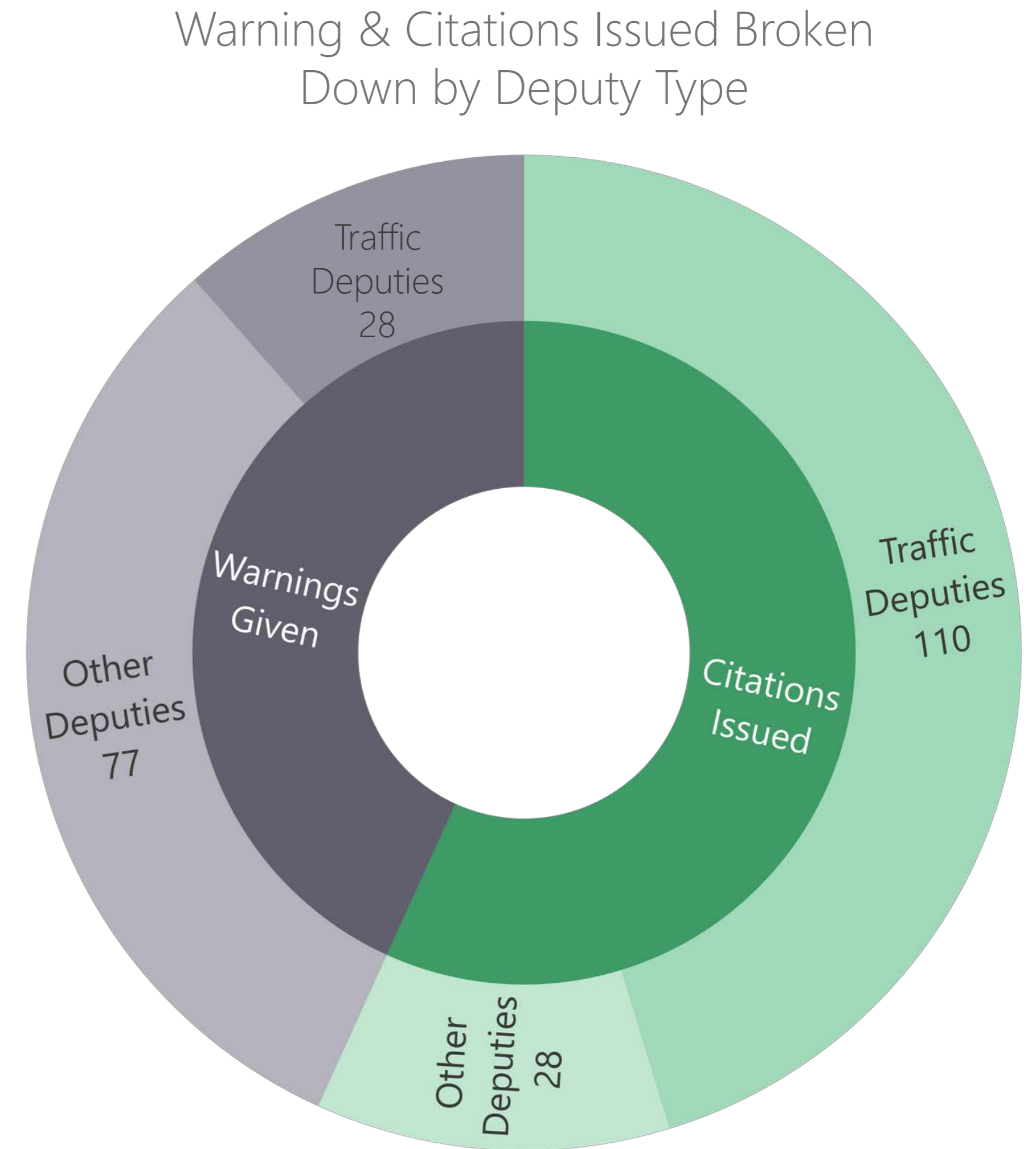
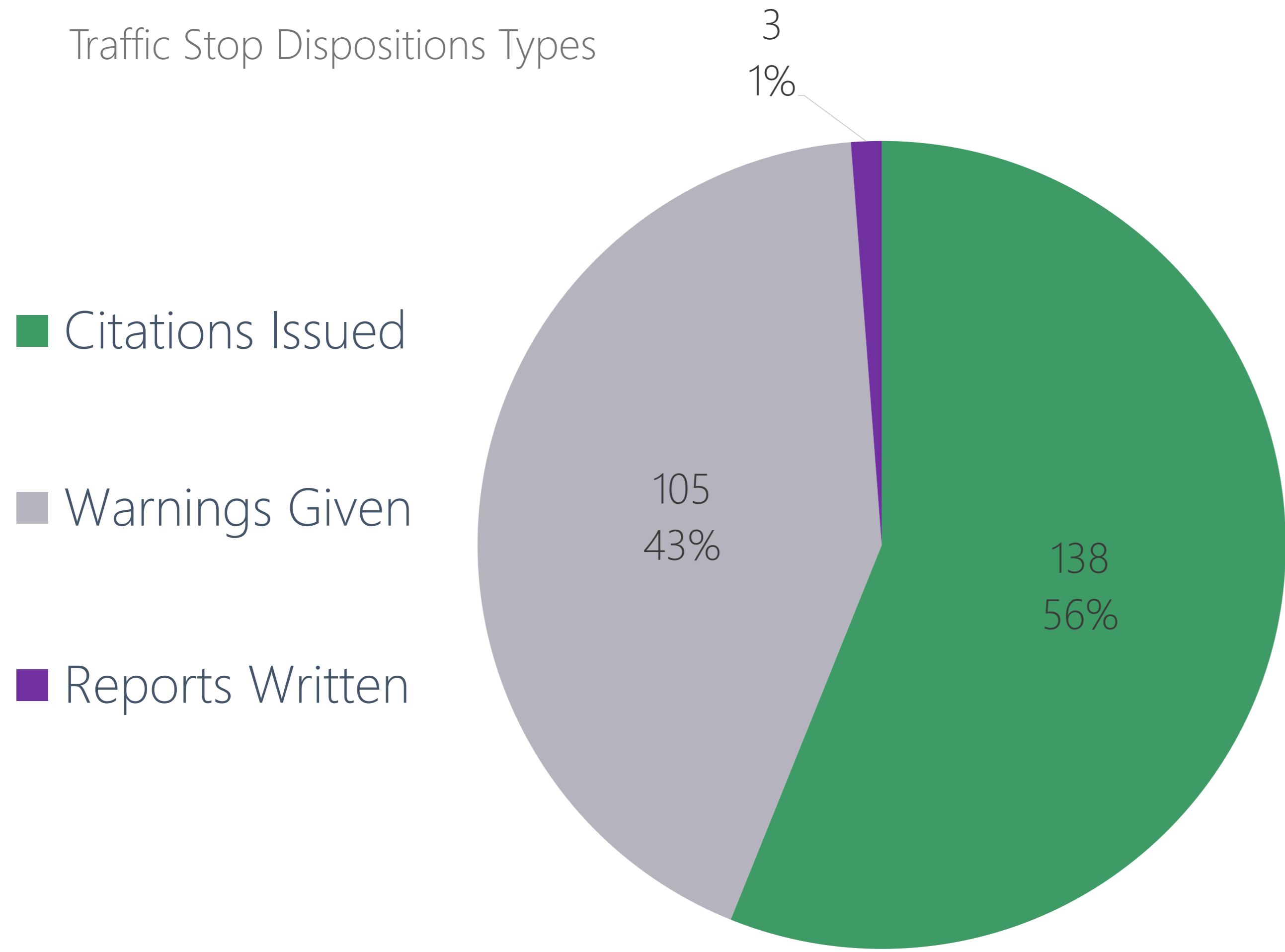


Breakdown of May Offense Reports Written by Top Charge



### Traffic Stop Dispositions

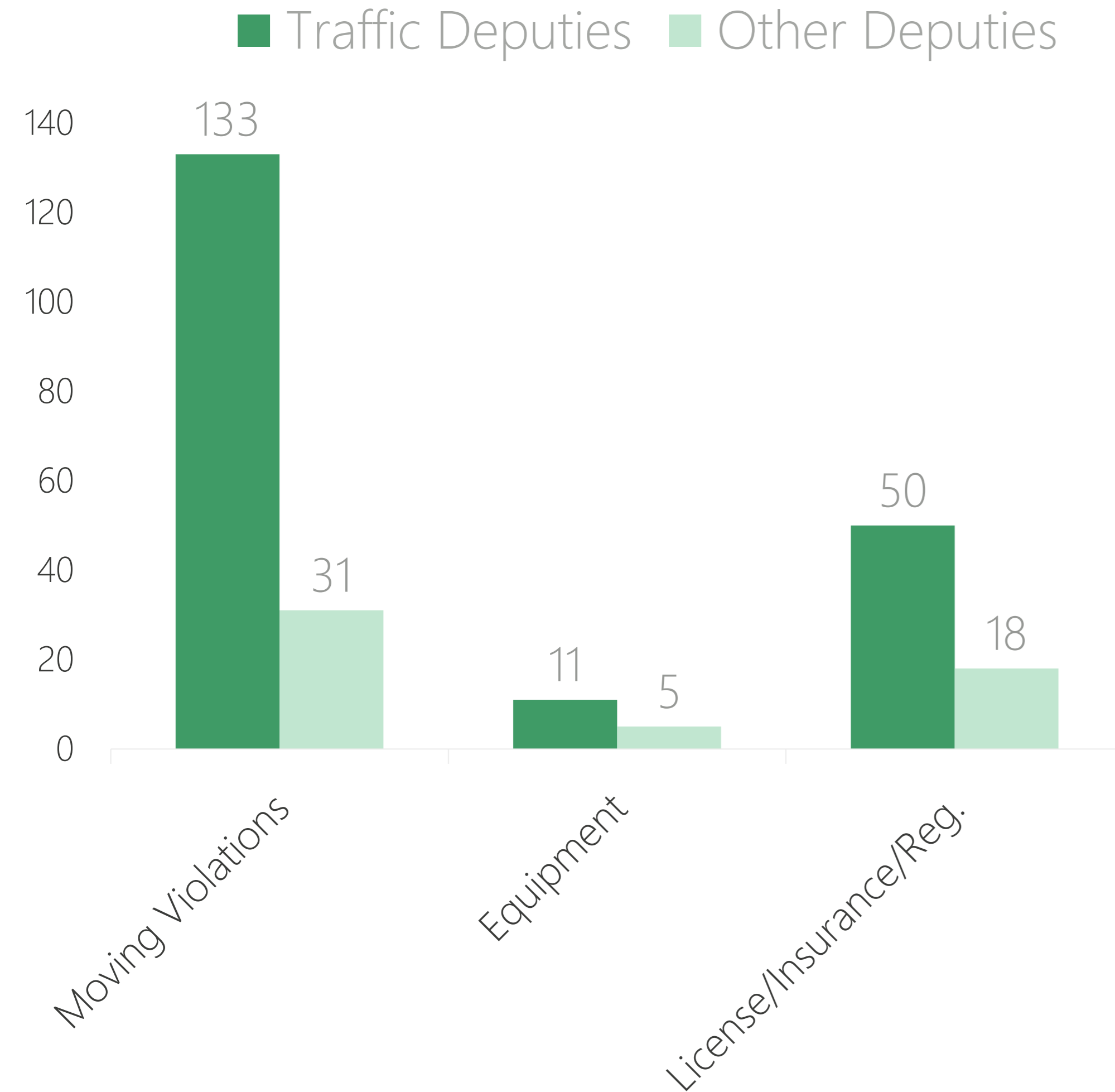

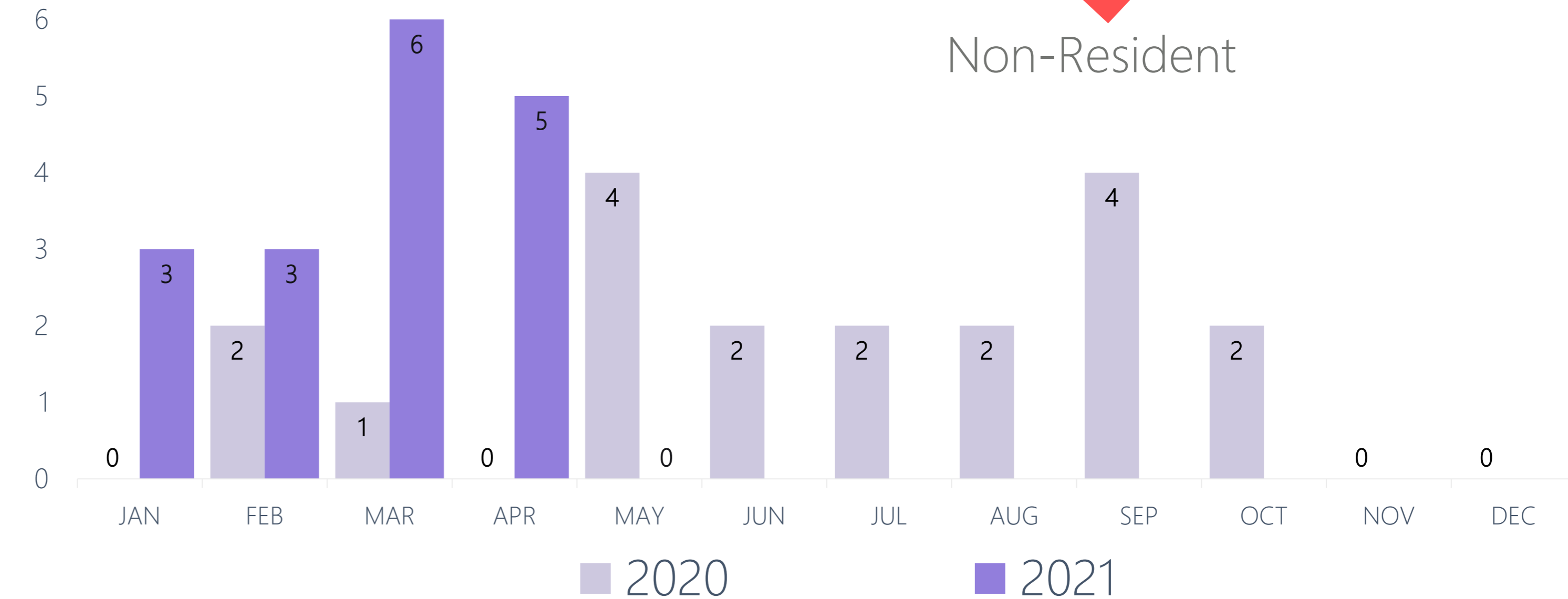
