
Permanent tax rates in the region:

Happy Valley's permanent tax rate is \$0.67 per \$1,000 of assessed property value. The passing of Measures 5 (1990) and 50 (1997) set limits on the amount of tax levied on property values for schools and government districts and set a permanent tax rate on all tax districts in Oregon. Due to these measures, Happy Valley's permanent tax rate of \$0.67 cannot be increased. The chart below breaks down the permanent tax rate in other cities in the region.

How would property tax revenues be distributed?

The City's permanent tax rate is 4% of the property tax assessed. If the parks and recreation levy passes, it would account for 3%. The rest of the tax bill goes to the schools, Clackamas County, and other service districts. If the levy passes, property owners would pay \$0.54 per \$1,000 of assessed value. If the parks levy does not pass, property owners would not pay \$0.54 per \$1,000 to the City of Happy Valley.
