PARTICIPATION INSTRUCTIONS

Participants MUST officially register to be part of the parade procession.

Check-in begins at 11AM.
Report to the PCC Structurals registration booth located at the corner of SE 145th Ave. & Ridgecrest Rd. You will be directed where to line up or park your vehicle once checked in. Walkers will start with vehicles at the end.

Make sure you are in your place at 11:45AM in time for judging.

Parade starts at noon and the procession takes roughly 30 minutes once movement begins.

Parade ends at the HV Park gazebo.
