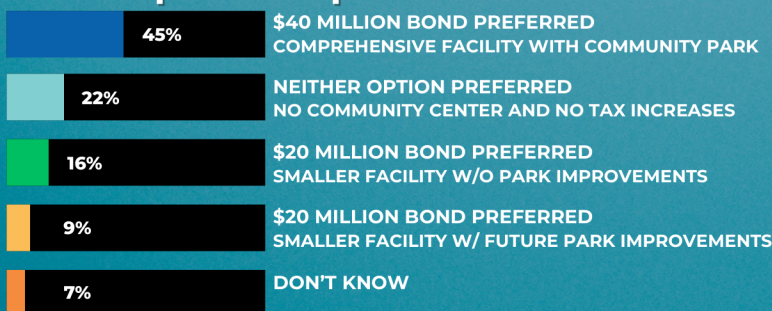

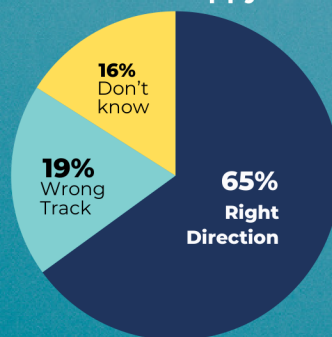

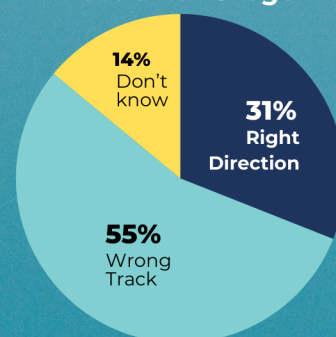
## Most voters believe HV is heading in the right direction.

### Direction of Happy Valley

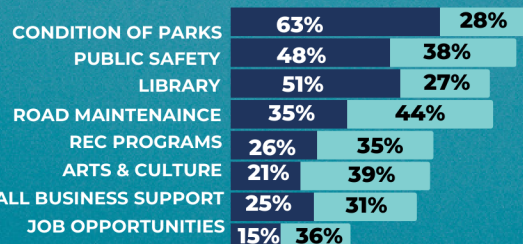


### Direction of Oregon



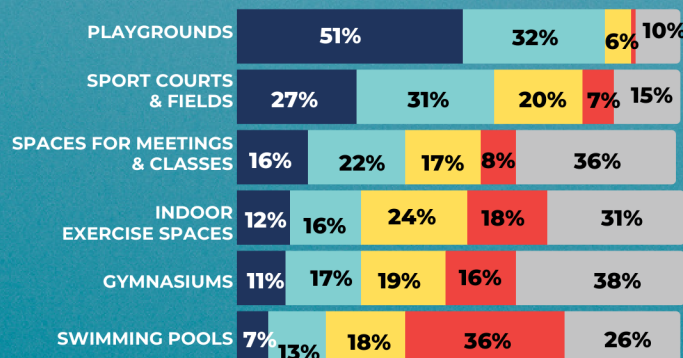
## Voter satisfaction with current HV services:
