5.	Will any structural alterations to your home or garage create a commercial space? The business may not change the Oregon Residential Specialty Code occupancy classification of any portion of the home.	
6.	Does the business produce noise, vibration, smoke, dust, odors, heat, or glare noticeable at or beyond the property line? The business may not cause offensive noise, vibration, smoke, dust, odors, heat, or glare noticeable at or beyond the property line.	
7.	Will there be on-site sales of items that are not incidental to a service being provided?         On-site retail sales are prohibited, except for the sale of items that are incidental to an allowed use.         Service Provided:	
8.	Will more than three clients/customers have associated with all businesses onsite visit	

the property within a 24-hour period? No more than three clients or customers may visit the property per day, except licensed daycare providers & residential care homes.

#### **EMPLOYEES**

9. Do any employees or volunteers live outside the home and travel to the home

for business activity or employment purposes?

Volunteers/employees who do not live onsite may not travel to the home for business activity, other than residential care homes or family child care homes.

- 10. Do any employees or volunteers pick up or deliver items to the site? Volunteers/employees who do not live onsite may not travel to the home for business activity, other than residential care homes or family child care homes.
- 11. Do employees or volunteers assemble onsite for instruction or dispatch? Volunteers/employees who do not live onsite may not travel to the home for business activity, other than residential care homes or family child care homes.

### VEHICLES/PARKING AND TRAFFIC

- 12. Will any commercial vehicles be parked on site (excludes small cars, trucks, SUVs)? No commercial vehicles associated with the business are allowed onsite. Commercial vehicles include those that are designed or used primarily for the transportation of property for compensation or profit, including dump trucks, tractortrailers, large commercial trailers, larger tow trucks, flat-bed trucks, larger box vans, vehicles with a gross vehicle weight rating or combination weight of 26,001lbs or more, vehicles designed to transport 16 or more persons, and vehicles designed to transport hazardous materials regardless of weight. Excludes fire trucks, emergency vehicles, motor homes and recreational vehicles operated solely for personal use, as well as SUVs, oversized pick-up trucks.
- 13. Will vehicles associated with the business block the sidewalk? *No blocking the sidewalk is allowed.*
- 14. Will there be deliveries by large trucks or large commercial vehicles? Deliveries are limited to delivery trucks typically found in a residential area, such as the United States Postal Service, UPS, Federal Express, messenger services, etc.
- 15. Will there be business deliveries during the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.? No commercial vehicle deliveries are allowed between 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.

#### SPECIAL USES

- 16. Are any of the following proposed?
  - Auto-body repair and painting
  - Auto sales
  - On-going mechanical repair conducted outside of an entirely enclosed building
  - Junk and salvage operations
  - Storage and/or sale of fireworks
  - Ambulance service
  - Animal hospital or veterinary services
  - On-site retail sales, except that the sale of items that are incidental to services provided onsite
  - Marijuana production, processing, wholesaling, and retailing
