SESSION TOPIC: Co-creating a Community Vision for the Sunrise Corridor



The presentation started by explaining how and when the Sunrise Corridor received its naming at the same time as the Sunset Highway during the 1990s. From there Jamie Stasny shared the how the current project has progressed as well as what is next.

After the Sunrise Expressway Phase 1 bill passed in 2009, the connection between I-205 and Highway 212 was underway, ultimately opening 2.15 miles of 4 lanes in July 2016.

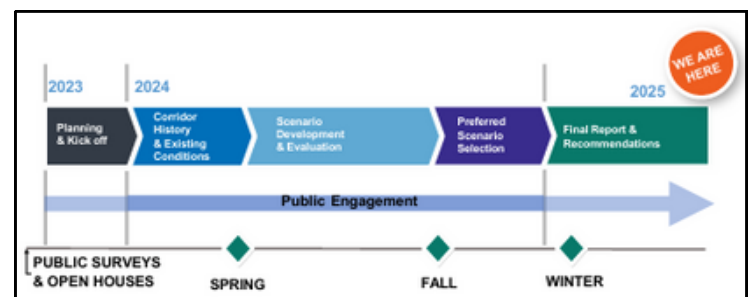
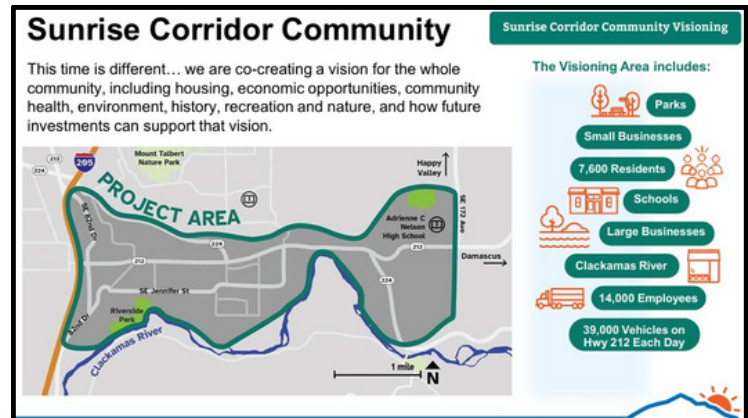
In 2020, a new measure for an 8 lane freeway was put to vote and soundly defeated. For the current Sunrise Corridor project took a system approach building a vision based on people and not just focused on a building a road.

A collaboration of 4 agencies co-created a vision for the whole community, including housing, economic opportunities, community health, environment, history, recreation and nature, and how future investments can support that vision. Numerous public sessions have been hosted.

Next Steps

- Host Community Celebration and Launch Sunrise community coalition to help prioritize and implement community actions from Vision Plan.
- Pending Funding: Initiate the NEPA Reevaluation for the Gateway Project

- Shared how Clackamas Fire was created when several communities came together for regional coverage
 - Currently exploring adding coverage in Sandy and Gladstone possibly in Fall
- Passage of Levy allows for full-time staffing at 23 stations as well as alleviating the reallocation of staff in times of emergencies
 - 13 new firefighters are in the latest Academy
 - Station 12: Logan in Oregon City will be fully staffed in July.
- Backyard burning closes June 15th (or sooner). Be sure to call before burning,

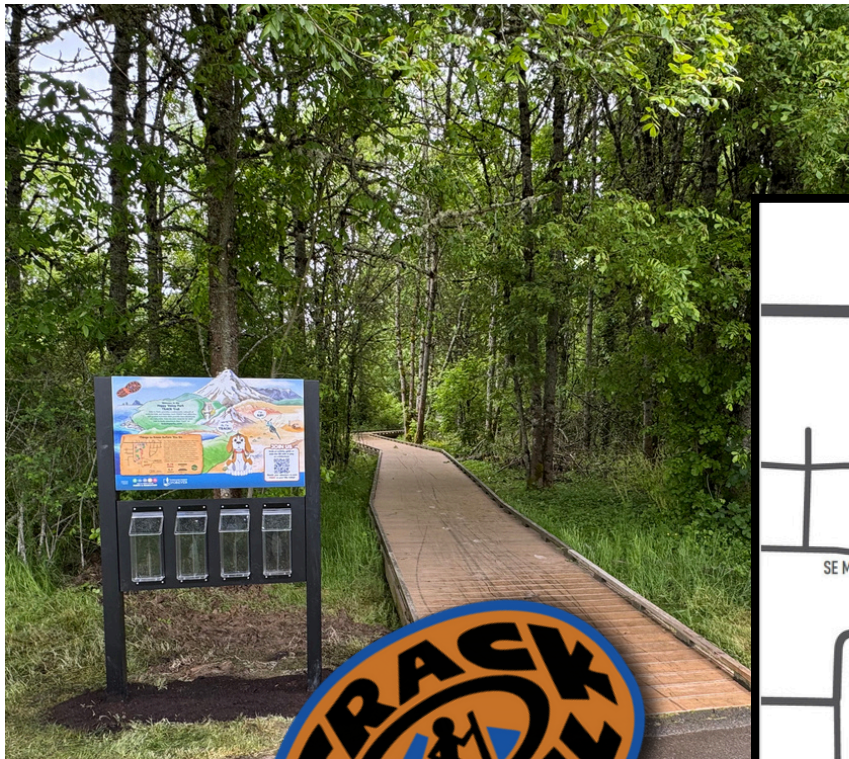
Happy Valley Park Welcomes Track Trail program

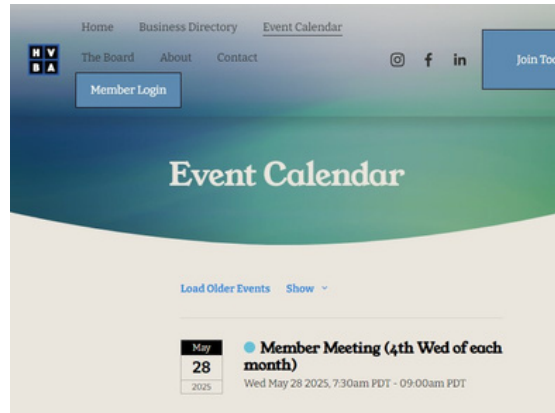
