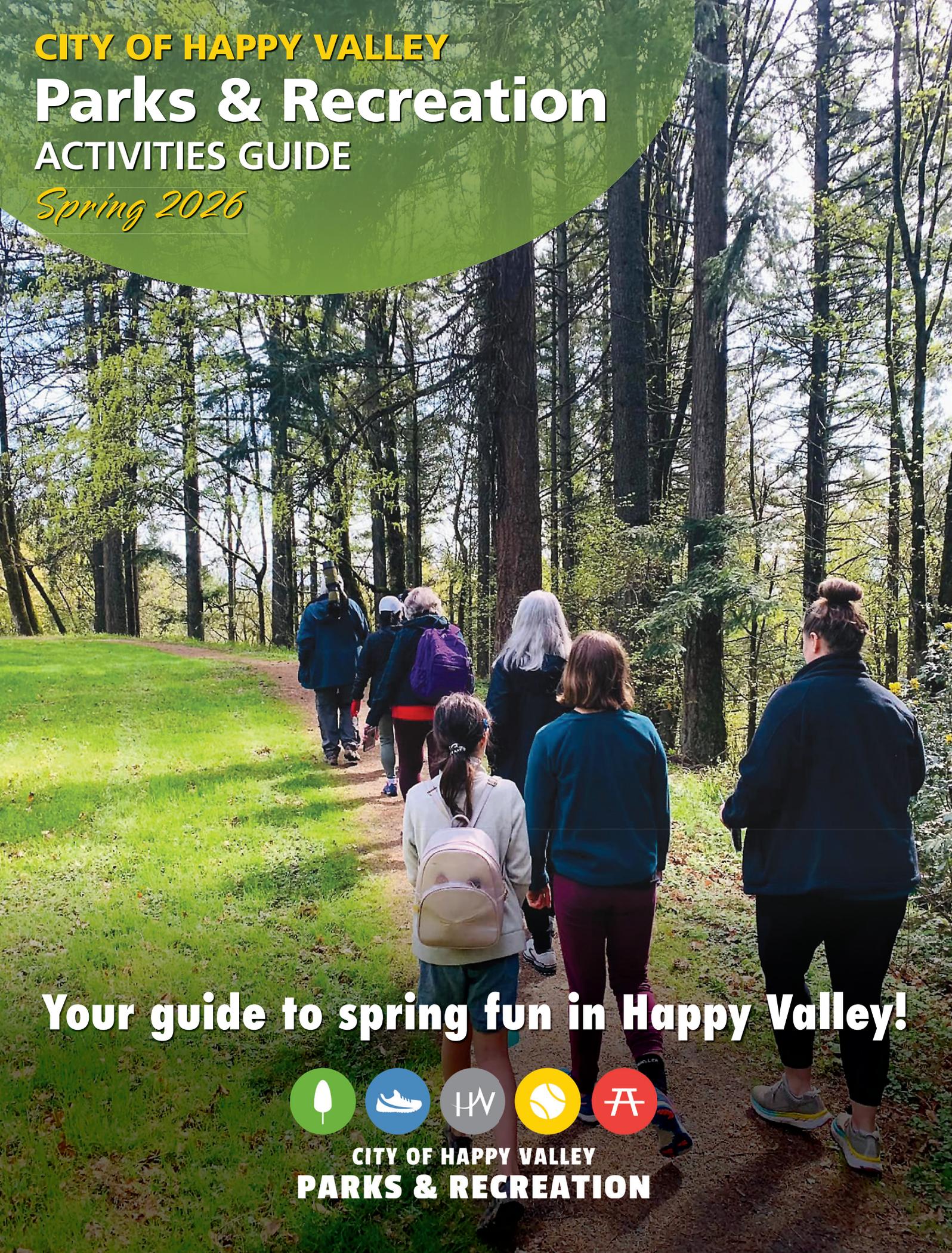

Moderately challenging, the hike is exposed most of the way on an out-and-back 5-mile trail with 1,200ft elevation gain.

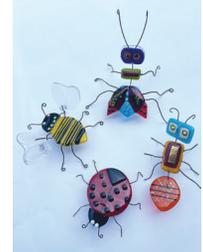
